TERM 3 - 2025-2026: ECAs Junior School Club Descriptions

Acrylic Painting	In this Acrylic Painting ECA, students will explore colour, texture, and creative techniques to produce expressive artworks. Through experimentation, students build confidence, resilience, and painting skills and come away with a collection of work to be proud of.
Animals Around the World	Explore a new habitat or environment around the globe each week and learn about the amazing animals that live there through projects and creative activities.
Arabic Gradual Reading	Arabic Gradual Reading ECA for non-native students helps students enjoy reading in Arabic. Using levelled words/sentences and fun activities, children build their vocabulary and reading skills step by step. In a friendly environment, they grow confident in reading aloud and talking about stories.
Arabic Stories & Tales	Watching educational stories in Arabic and English with follow-up creative activities (drawing and clay) and discussion of story elements and values.
Art	We will be exploring different artists and replicating a piece of their artwork using the techniques they used to create the piece.
Arts & Craft	Arts and Crafts ECA gives pupils a creative space to experiment with different materials and techniques while developing confidence and artistic skills. Each session encourages imagination, collaboration and pride in creating projects to take home.
Book Club	Promoting a love of reading and discussing books/texts, I ran this club last year and children loved it, we brought our own books, reviewed them, completed artwork and other activities based on them, swapped with each other, etc.
Breathing & Be – Invite	Breath & Be ECA introduces students to simple mindfulness practices that help them feel calm, focused, and confident. Through the BREATH approach, students learn to notice their body, understand emotions, improve attention, and use breathing strategies to manage stress. Sessions provide a safe space to pause, relax, and reflect while building positive habits that support wellbeing and learning both in and out of school.
Choir – Invite	Junior Choir is for selected students in Years 4 to 6 who demonstrate strong vocal potential, musical awareness, and a positive rehearsal attitude. Students are chosen based on: Accurate pitching and rhythmic security; Ability to listen and blend within an ensemble; Confidence and stage presence; Commitment and rehearsal discipline. In this ensemble, singers further develop healthy vocal technique, breath control, part-singing (including harmonies), expressive performance, and musical independence. Members represent the school at key concerts, assemblies, and special events. A high level of commitment is expected—because excellence isn't accidental. It's rehearsed. If you've been selected, it means you've shown potential. Now it's time to grow it. 🎵
Clay Club	Join Clay Club, where imagination meets hands-on creativity! This exciting ECA is perfect for anyone who loves to mould, sculpt, and bring their artistic ideas to life. Whether you're a beginner or a budding artist, Clay Club is the perfect place to express yourself, develop fine motor skills, and create something amazing to take home. Come ready to roll, squish, and sculpt—let's get our hands dirty and our creativity flowing! Students will need to bring their own clay!
Draw With Me	Learn to sketch and shade several favourites. In this step-by-step drawing session children learn how to sketch simple pictures and bring their work to life using shading techniques. Watch confidence grow as creativity flows, no experience needed, just imagination!
Drama and Performing Arts	Children will learn a new acting and performance skill each week and play fun games to boost communication skills. They will have scenes to perform and will also learn how to act through song - you do not need to be a confident singer to join, just someone who wants to learn how to act and perform.

Football	Join our Football ECA for an exciting blend of skill-building and teamwork on the field. Students will enhance their football abilities through drills, friendly matches, and a focus on sportsmanship. Unleash your passion for the game and score unforgettable memories!
Game Crafters	Guide you to understanding the concept of the Artificial intelligence, coding and programming Using: Scratch, Minecraft, Python, Web Design
Headspace Hub – Art	A welcoming after-school club where students build confidence, learn to manage big feelings, and practice calm, healthy ways to handle stress. Through fun activities, games and real-life skills, children grow stronger minds, better emotional control and a more positive sense of self together.
Holy Qur'an	This activity focuses on developing students' skills in reciting and memorizing the Qur'an. Students practice proper pronunciation (Tajweed).
Innovation Station	An exciting, hands-on club where pupils work together to solve problems and design innovative creations using simple, everyday materials.
Journaling	This ECA encourages students to express their thoughts, emotions, and creativity through writing. It fosters self-reflection, enhances writing skills, and promotes mindfulness, offering a safe space for young learners to explore and document their personal experiences.
Makers Studio	The Maker's Studio is a STEAM-focused art club for Year 6 pupils who love to build, design and create. Through projects using beads, mixed media and recyclable construction materials, students will explore engineering challenges, mathematical patterns, and artistic expression. This club encourages curiosity, experimentation and creative problem-solving in a supportive team environment.
Maths Puzzles	Sudoku, KenKen, Kakuro and more! Practise mathematical mindfulness whilst improving your mathematical recall.
Maths Games	During this ECA, the students will build number sense, logical thinking, spatial awareness, problem-solving, lateral thinking and strategic thinking through a variety of Maths games and puzzles.
Mini Movie Makers	Step into the world of imagination and creativity in our Animation Club! This exciting ECA gives students the chance to become young animators as they learn how to bring their stories, characters, and drawings to life—frame by frame.
Mini Skills Lab – Invite	Mini Skill Lab will focus on fun, hands-on activities to help children strengthen the small muscles in their hands and fingers that are essential for everyday tasks. Through engaging, play-based activities, students develop the coordination, control, and confidence needed for writing, cutting and completing fine motor tasks independently.
Multi Sports	Multi-Sport is a fun and energetic club where children can enjoy a variety of different sports each week. From football to basketball, athletics to team games, students build skills, fitness, and teamwork while having fun with friends.
Netball	Netball is a fast-paced, fun team sport that helps children build fitness, coordination, and teamwork. Players will learn the basic rules, practice passing, shooting, and defending, and enjoy friendly matches with their classmates.
Numbers Ninjas Club – Invite	Ready to level up your maths skills? Maths Champions Club is your chance to practise, improve and become more confident in class. We'll take on fun challenges, quick games and problem-solving tasks to help you get faster, stronger and more accurate with your maths. This is a space where you can ask questions, practise tricky bits, and push yourself to become a true maths champion.

Recorders	Recorder Club is a fun and engaging space where students build confidence through learning basic tunes and developing strong performance habits. Pupils practise correct posture, breathing, and finger technique while exploring simple melodies that strengthen their rhythmic and melodic understanding. Through group rehearsals, children learn collaboration and teamwork—listening carefully to one another, keeping in time, and supporting each other to create a balanced ensemble sound. The club encourages enjoyment, creativity, and a positive attitude towards performing together.
Repton Podcast	Join us each week to create, record, and produce your very own podcast! Students will learn how to plan episodes, write scripts, interview guests, use recording equipment, and edit audio. This club is perfect for creative thinkers, storytellers, and anyone who wants to develop confidence in speaking and presenting. By the end of the term, you'll publish a polished podcast to share with our school community!
Sewing	Sewing Club is a creative after-school activity where students learn basic sewing skills, develop fine motor skills, and express their creativity by making simple handmade projects. Students will learn how to use sewing tools safely, follow step-by-step instructions, and create useful and decorative items in a fun and supportive environment.
Sir John Port Award	The Sir John Port (SJP) Award is a structured extra-curricular programme for pupils in Years 3–6, designed to build confidence, independence and real-life skills through practical, engaging experiences. Progressing through Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum levels, pupils take part in ten key strands including first aid, money skills, community volunteering, fitness, sustainability, communication and personal interests. Each level increases in challenge, encouraging children not only to participate but to lead, reflect and make a positive impact within the school community. The SJP Award provides a strong foundation for future opportunities such as The Duke of Edinburgh's Award, helping pupils develop the character, resilience and leadership skills needed for success both in and beyond school.
Speak Up!	Speak Up! is an exciting ECA designed to help students develop their skills to create engaging presentations on topics they are passionate about, while building the confidence and techniques to become powerful public speakers.
Splash of Colour	Splash of Colour is a creative club where students explore the beauty of water colour painting. Throughout the term, we will learn and practise basic water colour techniques. Students will have the opportunity to experiment, develop their artistic confidence and express their creativity in a relaxed and supportive environment. Please note: Students will need to bring their own watercolour paint set to each session.
Stop motion video	Unleash creativity at our Stop Motion Video ECA and dive into the world of animation, learning to craft exciting stories frame by frame. Join the fun after school!
Table Tennis	Discover the thrill of fast-paced rallies, improve your coordination, and make new friends. Learn essential skills and techniques in a fun and supportive environment. Unleash your competitive spirit and have a smashing time after school!
Touch Rugby	Touch rugby is a fast-paced, non-contact sport that emphasizes agility, teamwork, and strategy, making it an inclusive and exciting variation of traditional rugby.
Wellness Club	This Well-Being ECA is a calm, supportive space where students can slow down, reflect and build positive habits for their mental and emotional health. Each session includes guided journalling to help children express their thoughts and feelings, creative colouring activities to promote relaxation and focus, and simple, child-friendly meditation techniques to develop mindfulness and self-regulation.
Unbounded Sparks - Invite	The 'Unbounded Sparks Club' is designed for students who enjoy thinking deeply, creatively and independently. Each session offers challenges that extend learning beyond the classroom — helping pupils stay grounded in core skills, become more rounded in their thinking, and explore unbounded ideas. Students will explore; critical thinking, public speaking and oracy, problem solving, STEM tasks, puzzles and brain games and much more, while working through an 'unbounded student' checklist.
